Booster's minutes for meeting date of October 15th, 2008

Meeting called to order @ 17:28

### Agenda Item#1-

Minutes were discussed, motion to approve made by Mary Heller, second by Leslie Dawson, all in favor.

### Agenda Item#2

Treasures report-Treasures report was discussed and Jeff motioned to approve w/ a second by Leslie, all in favor.

Agenda Item#3 Teachers requests-Cheryl Hart made a request for funding for electronic balances (4) for AP labs, they are \$250.00 each, about \$1200.00 with tax and shipping and she would use these immediately. Leslie made a motion to approve \$1170.42, Jeff seconded, all in favor.

### Agenda Item #4 Committee Reports/Appointments

- a. membership-Mary Heller stated that membership was way over budget! Kudos to Mary Heller. Mary stated that the most memberships were businesses as she has 48 business memberships and 72 regular memberships. Mary will put an ad in the paper that costs \$139.00. Scott Luke mentioned that the refs are paid for by football.

**Mike Agnitch also mentioned that there should be no toys, no dogs, and no skateboards can be ridden once inside the gate. Mike stated that kids will be ejected if they ride skateboards.**

#### **Agenda Item#7 Principals Report-**

**Mike stated there was a successful "Point Break" session with sophomores and seniors next Thursday-anti drug and alcohol presentation. Frank Romero mentioned that on Friday the counselors and teachers were going to go to a K-16 bridge program, this was a program to bridge students to make the transition to college easier and to transition to the junior college in particular. Frank stated that this program will eventually go down to the elementary school level. It was also mentioned that there was a tracking mechanism to see how our kids were doing in college. Jeff asked about the "every 15 minutes" program and Mike stated this is not a go as the research does not support any long term effects from this program.**
